

- Students <u>must</u> use a TI-Nspire on the STAAR test, AP tests, and on college entrance exams. (These calculators can also be used in college.)
- Our math courses have specific standards that directly <u>require</u> the use of graphing calculators.

The TI-Nspire CX graphing calculators are sold in retailers like Walmart, Office Depot, Staples, etc., and are generally around \$125. New and used TI-Nspire CX calculators can also be found on online sites such as Amazon.com and eBay.
